Dato Dr Loh Chit Sin is a Consultant Urologist at Hospital Picaso. He graduated with an MB ChB with honors, from Liverpool University and completed his urology training in the UK. Previously, he served as an Associate Professor at the University of Malaya and is a former President of the Malaysian Urological Association. As a senior member of the regional urological community, he is widely regarded as a key opinion leader in his chosen field of interest.

Dr. Loh has a longstanding interest in cancers affecting the prostate, kidneys, bladder, penis, and testis and has an extensive practice in these areas. Known for his expertise, he is a highly respected and experienced laparoscopic (keyhole) and robotic surgeon, proficient in performing a wide range of minimally invasive procedures.

Dr. Teh Guan Chou is a Consultant Urologist at Timberland Medical Centre in Kuching, Sarawak. He graduated with distinction from the University of Malaya in Kuala Lumpur in 1991. After completing his urological training at Hospital Kuala Lumpur in 1998, he spent a year in fellowship urological training at Flinders University and Repatriation General Hospital in Adelaide.

Dr. Teh served as the Head of the Department of Urology at Sarawak General Hospital from 2001 to 2023. He also held the position of President of the Malaysia Urological Association from 2012 to 2016. His primary areas of interest include uro-oncology, laparoscopic surgery, and robotic surgery. Recognized as one of the pioneering laparoscopic urological surgeons in Malaysia, Dr. Teh has presented numerous research papers on benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH), laparoscopic surgery, and robotic surgery at national and international urological meetings.
